Burial Information: Eternal Peace 4/2, Lot 2041 B-2.

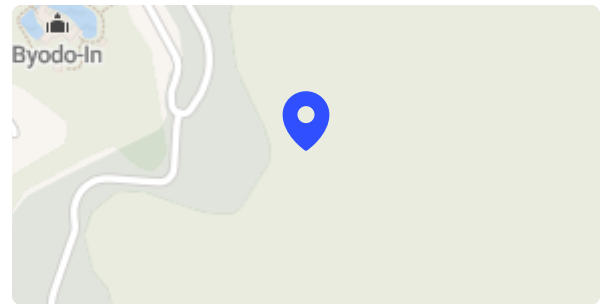

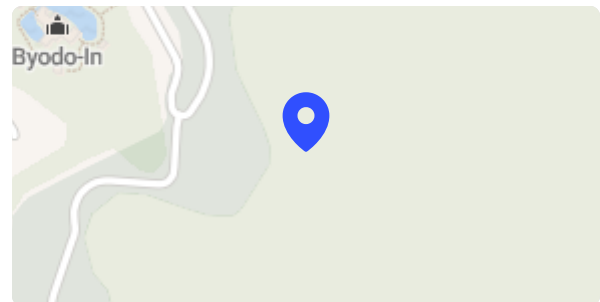
